FORMER DEPUTY MINISTER AND FORMER HILL & KNOWLTON V.P. JOIN KWG

Montreal, Canada – March 1, 2011 - **KWG Resources Inc.** (TSXV: KWG) is pleased to announce that Cameron Clark and Sheila Willis have agreed to serve as initial members of an Advisory Panel to provide counsel to the Company's management in the areas of public policy and communications.

Cameron Clark was Ontario's Deputy Minister of Northern Development and Mines from 1999 until his retirement to Thunder Bay in 2005, where he serves as a Trustee of Lakehead University and as a Director of the Quetico Foundation and of the Trans Canada Trail.
